Proposed Amendments to Design Law

A bill submitted to the Diet proposes several changes to the Japanese Design Law.

- 1. Graphic images recorded, shown, or displayed on walls, billboards, or via computer networks would be protected, provided that they are not associated with the function of a device or machine, such as video game or movie images.
- 2. Both the interior and exterior design of a building or real estate could be protected.
- 3. Related designs which are similar to another design specified as being a "principle design" may be registered. This system is described in detail in "Protection of Designs in Japan".
- 4. One application may be filed for multiple designs.
- 5. The duration of a design right would be extended from 20 years to 25 years.
- 6. Infringement Protection. A third party engaging in the manufacture or importation of critical components of a product protected by a registered design right may constitute infringement.

If passed, the changes to the Design Law will come into effect in early 2020.
